

Support Coordination VS Plan Management

Under the NDIS, you can choose to have Plan Management and Support Coordination services included in your plan. These services work together to help you to make the most of your NDIS funding in different ways.

Plan Managers:

Pay your providers' invoices

Send you monthly statements of your NDIS funding

Notify you when you're running out of funds

Answer questions about the financial aspect of your plan

Support Coordinators:

Connect you with services that suit your needs

Help you to understand your NDIS funding

Work with you to get ready for your planning meeting or review

Help you to make changes to your NDIS plan

How is this funded?

Plan Management and Support Coordination services are both fully paid for by your NDIS plan, meaning that there is no out-of-pocket expense for you.

If you want to have Plan Management and/or Support Coordination added to your NDIS plan, you can seek assistance from your Local Area Coordinator (LAC). You can find information about who your LAC is and how you can contact them on the last page of your NDIS Plan.

It is important to know that anyone can get Plan Management included in their plan. However, the NDIA will look at your situation and decide whether you're eligible to receive Support Coordination. You will not be considered eligible if you or your informal supports can manage these tasks.
